



Introduction

King Henry VIII College (KH8) is a prestigious co-educational day and boarding school offering Primary and Senior School education for students aged 3+ (Nursery) to 17+ (Year 12). Boarding is available for students aged 11+ (Year 7) and above. Admissions decisions are based on various factors, including assessments for Nursery through Year 10, iGCSE results or equivalent for 16+ entrants, school references, and interviews conducted by senior KH8 staff members, such as the Head of School, Head of Primary, Head of Senior School, or Assistant Head (Sixth Form).

Registration

We welcome enquiries regarding placements at KH8, whether via email, online forms, or pre-arranged appointments. However, expressing interest does not obligate parents to accept an offer or guarantee an offer from KH8.

To be considered for entry, an application form must be completed and the application fee paid. Incomplete applications or insufficient documents may delay the process. Once registered, students will be invited to sit for an assessment, either in person or online. Upon successful completion, an offer letter will be issued, and parents must sign the acceptance form and pay the acceptance fee to secure the place. The seat is assigned upon confirmation.

Full details regarding registration, application processes, and fees are available upon request.

Assessment

Assessments are conducted for students aged 3+ (Nursery) to 17+ (Year 12). While in-person assessments are preferred, online options are available, including platforms like Google Meet or Voov for students from China.

The assessment evaluates a student's abilities and potential. An interview follows to assess the student's English proficiency. Parents must provide the current school report or IGCSE/SPM equivalent before testing.

- **EYFS to KS1 (Years Nursery–2):** Reading and writing assessments and an interview with the Head of Primary.
- **KS2 (Years 3–6):** An online Cognitive Abilities Test (CAT4) and an interview with the Head of Primary.
- **KS3 and above (Years 7+):** An online CAT4, Password Test followed by an interview with the Head of Senior School or Deputy Head of Academic.

Parents must submit notice for withdrawals at the end of each term. Deadlines for submission of the withdrawal form are as follows:
